### **Job Profile:**

- Trustee and Company Director
- Meeting three times a year – currently on Mondays in January, May and October. At the moment, the May meeting is in person, the remainder via zoom
- A voluntary role, but with reasonable expenses paid
- Initially for a term of three years with an option to renew for up to a further two terms (a maximum of nine years)

### **Main Duties:**

The Board of Trustees is responsible for TWR-UK's strategy and financial security. While the day-to-day running of TWR-UK is delegated to the Chief Executive, trustees are the people who lead the charity and decide how to run it.

Trustee responsibilities include:

- contribute actively to the Board of Trustees' role in giving firm strategic direction, setting overall policy, and evaluating performance
- ensure the financial stability of TWR-UK
- ensure that TWR-UK complies with its governing document, charity law, company law and any other relevant legislation or regulations
- ensure that TWR-UK pursues its objects as defined in its governing document
- ensure that TWR-UK uses its resources exclusively in pursuance of its objects
- safeguard the good name and values of TWR-UK
- ensure the effective and efficient administration of TWR-UK
